Then I included a few more photos taken over the years, probably including a few duplicates. One feature is a grouping of portraits of Wayne, Dad and Mom taken for school or work.

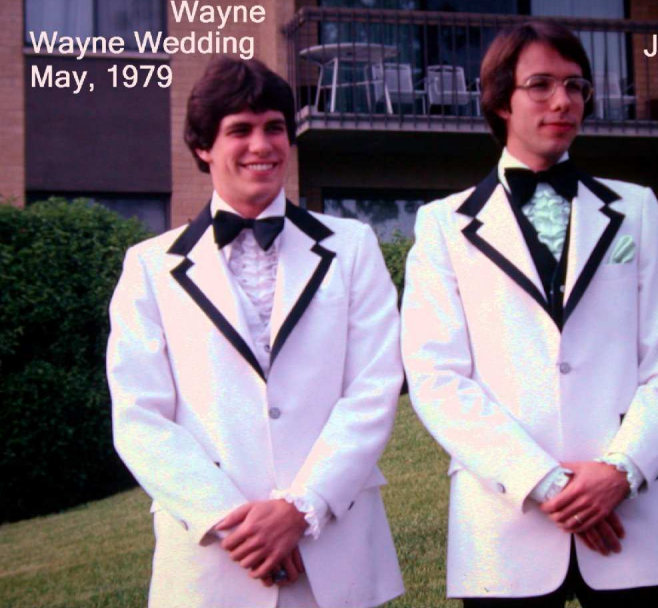
The book ends with the slide show that Dad put together for their 60th wedding anniversary in 2008, followed by a few photos taken at Christmas 2011.
